- ★ Practice writing daily to build a habit and improve skills.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting story structure can lead to confusing narratives.
- ✗ Overusing complex vocabulary may alienate readers.
- ✗ Forgetting to show rather than tell emotions can weaken character connections.
