DEFINITION

Creative writing in Welsh allows you to express ideas and stories using the language. It combines language skills with imagination to create unique pieces.

KEY CONCEPTS

Story Structure

Character Development

Creating relatable characters makes your stories more engaging and believable.

Descriptive Language

Using vivid adjectives and adverbs enhances imagery and draws readers into your writing.

Dialogue Writing

Writing realistic conversations helps to develop characters and move the plot forward.

Editing and Revising

Reviewing your work improves clarity and quality, making your writing stronger.

MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Use the acronym 'SCDDE' for Story, Character, Dialogue, Description, Edit.
- ★ Visualize a story map to remember the structure.
- ★ Associate characters with real-life people to enhance development.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to plan the story structure.
- ✗ Using too many adjectives, making sentences cluttered.
- ✗ Forgetting to proofread for grammar and spelling errors.
