MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'W.I.N.' for cleaning: Wash, Interior, and Wax.
- ★ Think of 'T.W.I.N.E.' for tire care: Tire shine, Wash, Interior, and New look.
- ★ Use the acronym 'C.A.R.' to recall: Clean, Apply wax, Refresh.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Using household cleaners on car surfaces can damage finishes.
- ✗ Neglecting to dry the car can lead to water spots.
- ✗ Skipping regular cleaning can cause buildup and damage over time.
