- ★ Think of editing as telling a story with a beginning, middle, and end.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Overusing transitions can distract viewers.
- ✗ Neglecting audio quality can ruin the video experience.
- ✗ Failing to stabilize footage can make videos unwatchable.
