DEFINITION

KEY CONCEPTS

Clean Before Storage

Always wash and dry your motorbike to remove dirt and grime that can cause corrosion.

Battery Maintenance

Disconnect the battery or use a battery tender to prevent it from draining during storage.

Tire Care

Inflate tires to the recommended pressure to avoid flat spots while the bike is stored.

Covering the Bike

Use a breathable cover to protect your bike from dust and moisture without trapping humidity.

Fuel Stabilization

Add fuel stabilizer to the tank to prevent fuel degradation during long storage periods.

EXAMPLES

- Wash and dry your bike before putting it away.
- Use a battery tender to keep the battery charged.
- Cover your bike with a breathable cover.

- ★ Think of 'Breathe' for breathable covers to avoid moisture.
- ★ Visualize a well-maintained bike in a cozy garage.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Neglecting to clean the bike before storage.
- ✗ Forgetting to disconnect the battery.
- ✗ Not using a cover, leading to dust accumulation.
