MEMORY TIPS

- ★ Remember 'PLAY': P for Problem-solving, L for Learning, A for Artistic, Y for Youthful.
- ★ Use the acronym 'CAMP' for Creative Activities: Create, Art, Move, Play.
- ★ Think of 'NICE' for Nature, Imagination, Creativity, Exploration.

COMMON MISTAKES

- ✗ Focusing too much on structure rather than allowing free play.
- ✗ Neglecting to participate in creative activities alongside the child.
- ✗ Over-scheduling activities, leaving no time for spontaneous creativity.
