DEFINITION

Fabric types are the various materials used in sewing projects. Understanding them helps you choose the right fabric for your creations.

KEY CONCEPTS

Cotton

A versatile, breathable fabric ideal for beginners and everyday clothing.

Silk

A luxurious, smooth fabric that drapes beautifully but requires careful handling.

Linen

A strong, breathable fabric perfect for warm weather but prone to wrinkling.

Polyester

A durable, wrinkle-resistant synthetic fabric that is easy to care for.

Wool

A warm, insulating fabric used for cold-weather garments, often requiring special care.

EXAMPLES

- Use cotton for a simple summer dress.
- Choose silk for a fancy evening gown.
- Select polyester for durable everyday wear.

- ★ Remember 'C' for Cotton: Casual and Comfortable.
- ★ Silk is Smooth: Think of it as a luxury treat.
- ★ Linen = Light and Loose: Great for summer.
